After almost fifty years of being self-employed, developing and growing his construction supply business into a powerhouse in Louisville, KY. During those years, Robert gave encouragement and plentiful advice to five of his employees to become successfully self-employed. Robert turned his company, Greenrose, Inc., over to his children in 2010, and then retired.

As president of the Lions Club in Odom County, Robert was intensely engaged in community well-being. When he became a Decan at the Crestwood Baptist Church in Crestwood, his dream to provide teenagers with a powerful, unforgettable experience, came true; he initiated Humanitarian rebuilding efforts for New Orleans.

Robert's main goal was to introduce high school kids to social skills, teach them to help those in need, and allow the young people to discover the value of team work and depending on each other. Over the course of seven years, Robert took approximately 500 young people from his church and local high schools to the New Orleans area; besides learning practical and work-related skills, the boys and girls build three houses culminating in the joy of turning them over to the families in Bay Saint Louis, who had lost everything during Katrina.
